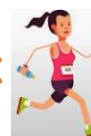

Everyone is already bursting with fun ideas to help raise funds for our school community! Please come along to our first meeting for a cuppa, a chat and to share fundraising ideas!

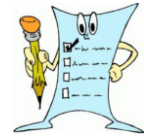
