Beginning in September, pre-payment for ALL school services is essential. Unless, prearranged through the official childcare scheme, your child will not be able to avail of afterschools, swimming, music tuition or receive milk, if pre-payment has not been received.

CONSULTATION RESULTS - 2pm Friday finish

We have had **43 parental returns** regarding 2pm Friday finish. The results are as follows:

9 parental returns disagree to a 2pm finish each Friday

34 parental returns agree to a 2pm finish each Friday.

As a result of whole school consultation (Parents, School staff and Board of Governors), we will trial a 2pm finish each Friday in Term 1 and review the arrangement around Christmas. In reaching this decision the following has been considered:

- 1. Parental comments as part of consultation.
- Staff jointly believe that the extra time available during the week for teachers to be with their own classes will enhance the quality of education received by the pupils 2-3pm.
 - Y1& 2 teachers will now be able to focus on additional provision, i.e. Literacy and Numeracy support for children in Key Stage 1 & 2 (Monday – Thursday) as oppose to covering a class between 2-3pm.
- 4. Clubs and societies will continue to take place on a Friday as normal between 1.15pm and 2pm.
- Pupils should be arriving to school at 8.50am, ready for a 9am lesson start each morning.

After-schools will continue to available as usual from 2pm.
